BILATERAL ARTERIAL DOPPLER

Duplex doppler scan of the lower extremity arteries bilaterally was performed. Flow measurements and static images were obtained during real time sonography.

History: Pain.

Generalized spectral broadening is apparent indicating generalized mild atherosclerotic irregularity. No ulcerated plaque detected and no focal stenosis evident.

Findings correspond to normal ankle/toe-brachial indexes results.

IMPRESSION: NO SIGNIFICANT STENOSIS PRESENT.
